- The best way to get administration support is to compile everything and have your ducks in a row before proposing it. Policies, forms, and connections to the teks.
- Make sure animals are being used to cover a TEK/Lesson and not just in the classroom for show & tell
- Cover yourself by requiring permission forms for not just the class you will be working with live animals but all classes in your room since animals will be present
 - \circ $\,$ Have Liability forms for students and adults when accepting animals
- Need equipment? Accommodate and use what you have until you can get what is needed. Apply for local/school grants
- Provide a service to aid in skill development:
 - Dog daycare
 - Dog Spa- kids all had different jobs
 - Dog Grooming
 - Vaccine Clinic
 - Microchip Clinic
 - Animal Treats Sale
