

## Legislative

## <u>Policy</u>

<u>Purpose:</u> To guide the Association for legislative matters.

- 1. A list of priorities will be developed for each legislative session.
- 2. Provide support to those in favor of agricultural education with PAC money collected at our conference.
- 3. Monitor elections to provide knowledge about which candidates are supportive of agricultural education, career and technology education, and public education. Maintain a working list of teachers and retired teachers in each Congressional district with personal contact with a Representative or Senator.
- 4. Actively promote agricultural education before and during the legislative session.
- 5. Maintain talking points that would help members write a letter using correct terminology.
- 6. The ATAT will cooperate with the Foundation with the Legislative Lead. The Association will encourage all members to take a proactive approach to legislation that affects our programs and the students we teach.

## **Operational Protocols**

- 1. Monitor legislation that affects agricultural education and other education issues and concerns and provide outlines of critical education issues.
- The Directors meet with teachers and stress the importance of contact with legislative members about our program. Stress the importance of the Board of Directors to visit their Legislators.
- 3. Encourage districts and areas to invite state representatives and senators to their FFA meetings to develop relationships with these individuals.
- 4. Provide a link on the ATAT website to contact and address Legislators. Develop and maintain a list of all State Representatives by district.
- 5. Provide a list of proper terminology to use when addressing legislators to support or lack support for a bill.

- 6. Encourage teacher participation in the Legislative Lead.
- 7. The Association sponsors a legislative-type meeting at the ATAT Professional Development Conference that includes a speaker who can address the prevailing moods of the legislature regarding legislation affecting the Association. Any other legislative resource persons who would help inform the Directors should also be included.
- 8. Encourage the Board of Directors to meet with Legislators during the session.
